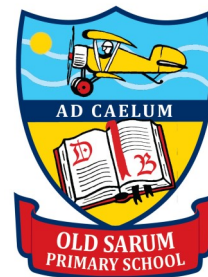

Clubs

Healthy Me Course

The Healthy Me programme, is designed for young people aged 7-11, who are above the healthy weight for their age. The programme is designed for young children and their families, where accommodation is made to include siblings and parents/guardians/ responsible adults within the sessions.

The Healthy Me programme operates across within Wiltshire including Salisbury. It is a **FREE** 10 week course, with a 3, 6 and 12 month follow up designed as keeping in touch activity days. Each session takes place weekly, lasting 1.5 hours and contains an array of nutritional and lifestyle information as well as lots of fun physical activities and games. The programme operates 3 times a year alongside the Wiltshire schools calendar, breaking for school holidays.

Families are able to self-refer to the programme but referrals can also be made by medical or healthcare professionals on a family's behalf.
