



Predators

In **Topic**, we are going to be learning all about different Predators around the world. We will be creating animal food chains, researching all about our favourite predators to find out about where they live and their special features, finding out which predators live on each continent, drawing some distinctive predators and even creating our very own Ultimate Predator.

In **English**, we'll be working on a few stories. Firstly, we will be reading 'I'll take you to Mrs Cole' and the children will be adapting the story and writing their own ideas. After that, we will be reading 'Christophe's Story' and will be working on letter writing. We will then go into some poetry and find out about the different poetic techniques.

In **Maths**, we will be continuing with a mastery approach, using Maths No Problem to work on understanding and using numbers to 1000, including addition and subtraction. We will also be working daily on our times tables, focussing on our 2, 3 and 4x tables at first.

In **Science**, we will be learning to:

- identify that animals, including humans, need the right types and amount of nutrition, and that they cannot make their own food; they get nutrition from what they eat.
- identify that humans and some other animals have skeletons and muscles for support, protection and movement.

For the first 6 weeks up until October half term, **PE** will be on Tuesdays and Thursdays. After half term, it will change to Tuesdays and Wednesdays.

Spellings will be given out every Friday and children will be tested every Friday. They will be written on Class Dojo and in the classroom.
