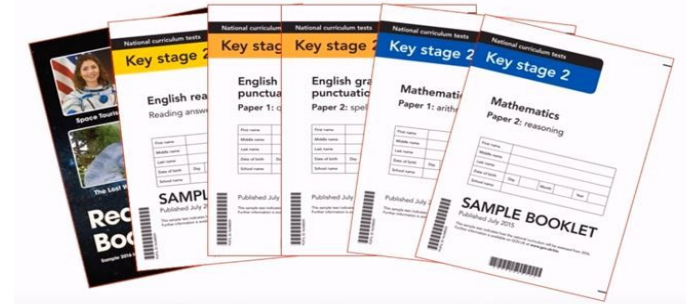

WHY DO WE HAVE SATS?

Statutory in Y6



They are not about passing or failing but about assessing the level your child is working at.

The results will be used to predict performance at GCSE (high schools and secondary schools are held accountable for this.)

The results are used at Berwick Middle School to support pupils in KS3.

The results are passed to high schools and used to determine support up to GCSE.

PRACTICE SAT RESULTS

Pupils have already sat a round of tests and will sit further tests throughout the year.

Pupils will be given a personal target for the end of the year and a result from each practice SAT.

The target is based on how well pupils did in their KS1 SATS at first school (for those who did this in England only).

For maths and reading results are shown as a number called a scaled score, which is then converted to a level.

For writing pupils are given a level.

HOW CAN YOU SUPPORT?

Practise times tables up to 12.

Read with your children every day, talk about what they are reading and discuss the use of punctuation.

Use the revision guides and allow them time to work on these or work through with them.

Check your child's planner for homework and ensure that they complete it.

Practice SAT papers are available online - complete them at home.

Don't take holidays in term time!

Ensure children eat well and sleep well.

Don't put *too much* pressure on children and encourage them to relax and enjoy other things.
