Geography - We are going to:

- Begin to locate key areas on a world map

Art / Design Technology - We are going to:

- Develop our pencil and fine motor control when colouring / painting

Science - We are going to:

- Look at different animals, their similarities and differences
- Look at other animal classifications
- The habitats of the animals and their basic needs

Mathematics - We are going to:

- Count accurately forwards and backwards (within 20)
- Find one more and one less than numbers
- Continue to work on number bonds to 10 and 20
- Solve problems involving addition and subtraction
- Compare items based on their length and height
- Solve simple problems involving length and height
- Begin to sequence events by time e.g. events of the day, days of the week

Reading - We are going to:

- Focus on our fluency when reading, applying our knowledge of phonics
- Read a variety of texts (fiction and non-fiction)
- Read more high frequency words on sight
- Retell stories we are reading
- Be able to read topic vocabulary on sight

Emotional Development – We are going to:

- Develop our friendships and interactions with each other
- Discuss what characters may have felt like and show some degree of sympathy
- Work together in groups on tasks, with the support of an adult
- Develop our role play skills
- Develop our understanding of other people's opinions and views
