<p><u>ICT</u></p> <p>Create an information poster about Inuits.</p>	<p><u>D + T</u></p> <p>Create an arctic or Antarctic themed shoebox habitat.</p>	<p><u>Music</u></p> <p>Listen to a piece of inuit music. Record how it makes you feel and what instruments you can hear.</p>	<p><u>Geography</u></p> <p>Research a country that is in the Arctic. How does it compare to our country?</p>
