## Sports Funding Allocation for 2018/19

### Sports Funding Allocation for 2018/19 - £19,202

#### Pupils

- Increase extra-curricular sports provision for all pupils in particular KS1 pupils so at least 50% of pupils attend extra-curricular clubs
- Purchasing equipment to ensure high quality sports lessons for all pupils
- Pupils are held in high esteem when representing EPPS at sporting events and feel proud of their sporting achievements
- To experience 'competition' at individual and team level with a focus on building resilience, perseverance and respect.
- All pupils increase their fitness/stamina levels by being involved in the 'Daily Mile'
- Identification of pupils who have a talent in different sporting events.
- Increase % to 85%+ of pupils who can swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of 25 meters by the end of Year 5.

#### Staff Development

- Cover for Sport and Well Being Lead to team teach PE with staff who lack confidence in teaching high quality PE sessions
- Partnership work with PE teachers from the Havering Sports Collective with a focus on:
- Early identification of more able and talented pupils in sporting fields to encourage further development of their talent in the sport inside and outside of school
- Staff training in use PE Passport –PE curriculum scheme of work to ensure high quality PE sessions are being taught across the primary phase.
