- Make your own slush drink by freezing a cup of juice, How long does it take to freeze. Record your investigation in a scientific report.

- Set up a melting experiment. Put ice in different places and see which melts first. Present your findings using pictures.
- Keep a food diary for a week
- Go to the supermarket and try something you've never tried before - write what you thought about it.
