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**Physical Education Statement for the year:**

Throughout the year the required number of Physical Education (PE) hours per week was carried out across the school, with extra included when the opportunity arose.

As the school is a member of the South Hunsley School Sports Partnership (SHSSP), we have taken part in many competitions throughout the year, with much success and with children ranging from Year Three to Year Six. The competitions and results are as follows:

To cater for these competitions, the children's interests and their health needs, a wide range of PE extra-curricular clubs was provided throughout the course of a year. These include: Boys Football, Girls Football, Netball, Rounders, Dance and Hockey.

The SHSSP also put on Festivals of Sport for Year Six and Year Five pupils, providing opportunity for competition and participation for children in these year groups, across a range of sports.

An additional event, taken part in by the school annually, is Haltemprice Sports; an athletics competition in which schools from the wider East Yorkshire area take part. The schools form a committee which comes together many times throughout the year, with differing responsibilities in order to organise the event, and it is a culmination of the children's hard work in athletics. Key Stage Two children take part in this evening event which is held in July. The children took part in numerous school trials and internal school competitions before being selected to take part in the event to ensure that every child has the opportunity to develop their skills while trying out for positions.

We have also organised and played inter-school friendly football matches with Elloughton and Marfleet Primary Schools as well as competing against numerous schools in the Humberside Cup Football Competition.

As in previous years, there were many Young Sports Leaders (YSL) trained and put into practice. These children were taken from Year Six, trained following the YSL programme and were able to visit the Key Stage One children (ranging from Foundation Stage to Year Two) to carry out both competitive games and skills based activities with groups of children.

Due to this high level of competition, and the vast amount of extra-curricular opportunities at North Ferriby C. E. Primary School, the school was awarded with the Sainsbury's School Games Silver Kitemark for the academic year 2015/16. The SHSSP also provided the opportunity for staff to attend professional development courses over a range of sports and physical education elements. These included: Tag rugby, Badminton, Tennis, Football, Squash and Cricket. These courses were useful in developing the staff confidence in teaching these areas of PE, for generating ideas and to aid in the implementation of schemes of work. The school also took part in National School Sport Week, holding separate sports days for both Key Stages.
