In maths our focus will be counting, number recognition, measuring and looking at shapes in the environment.

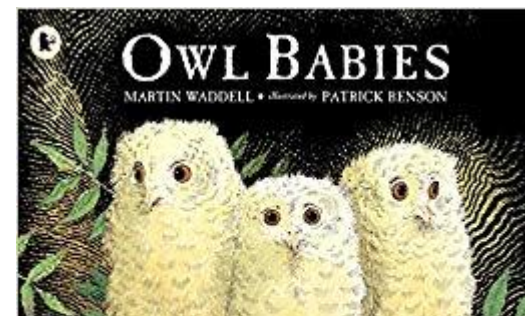


Learning
