Dear parents/carers,

Please find attached a timetable of the extracurricular opportunities on offer for the autumn term. We have thought hard about the different types of activities we can offer the children this year and have divided all of the extra-curricular 'clubs' into one of three categories.

Team Lyneham- These are sports based activities with an emphasis on cooperation and respect. On completing a Team Lyneham course, children will receive a navy badge to wear on their uniform.

Home Lyneham- These are life skills based courses and offer a range of practical activities designed to enhance self-reflection with an emphasis on kindness and responsibility. On completing a Home Lyneham course, children will receive a black badge to wear on their uniform.

Create Lyneham- These are creative opportunities and are designed to help children build self-confidence and stimulate imagination. On completing a Create Lyneham course, children will receive an orange badge to wear on their uniform.

This year, to celebrate the commitment and work that children put into their attendance and participation in these activities, we have decided to award children with a 'Graduation Badge' on completion of the term. They will be encouraged to wear their badges with pride and try to earn a variety of them through the course of the year by trying different types of clubs in different terms.

The first round of applications opens now and the clubs will begin next week. Your child will be bringing home a booking form today. Please discuss the importance of commitment with your children. When they take a place in a club, it means that another child may not be able to so it is important that they honour their commitment and see it through until the end. This way they will also be awarded with their completion certificate and a badge. There are limited spaces available for each activity, but we will endeavour to ensure that children get their first choice wherever possible and at least once a year. There are limited spaces available so we need to limit children to attending one activity per term until we can measure how popular certain things are and ensure all children have an opportunity to take part in something.

We hope that there will be something for everyone in our menu, but we are always open to suggestions for future opportunities. Please feel free to visit us during our curriculum consultation morning next month to share any ideas you think would be helpful or more inclusive in the coming terms.
