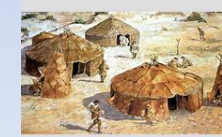

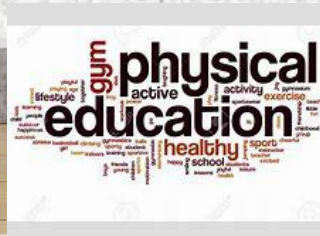
English and Mathematics
