## DOMESTIC CHURCH - FAMILY

<b>Year 1</b>	<b>FAMILIES</b> - God's love and care for every family
<b>Year 2</b>	<b>BEGINNINGS</b> - God is present in every beginning
<b>Year 3</b>	<b>HOMES</b> - God's vision for every family
<b>Year 4</b>	<b>PEOPLE</b> - The family of God in Scripture
<b>Year 5</b>	<b>OURSELVES</b> - Created in the image and likeness of God
<b>Year 6</b>	<b>LOVING</b> - God who never stops loving

## SUGGESTIONS FOR HOME ACTIVITIES

Make a collage using family photographs of all the significant family members—grandparents, parents, children, aunts, uncles etc. who show God's love.

Include those who have died.

## JUDAISM

Pupils will study various aspects of Judaism for one week. Ask them what they have been learning about.

<b>Year 1</b>	<b>BELONGING</b> - Baptism: an invitation to belong to God's family
<b>Year 2</b>	<b>SIGNS AND SYMBOLS</b> - Signs and symbols in Baptism
<b>Year 3</b>	<b>PROMISES</b> - Promises made at Baptism
<b>Year 4</b>	<b>CALLED</b> - Confirmation: a call to witness
<b>Year 5</b>	<b>LIFE CHOICES</b> - Marriage, commitment and service
<b>Year 6</b>	<b>VOCATION AND COMMITMENT</b> - The vocation of priesthood and religious life

## SUGGESTIONS FOR HOME ACTIVITIES

Talk to someone who has been to a Baptism and/or Confirmation about their memories of this celebration.

## ADVENT/CHRISTMAS - LOVING

<b>Early Years</b>	<b>BIRTHDAY</b> - Looking forward to Jesus' birthday
<b>Year 1</b>	<b>WAITING</b> - Advent: a time to look forward to Christmas
<b>Year 2</b>	<b>PREPARATIONS</b> - Advent: preparing to celebrate Christmas
<b>Year 3</b>	<b>VISITORS</b> - waiting for the coming of Jesus
<b>Year 4</b>	<b>GIFT</b> - God's gift of love and friendship in Jesus
<b>Year 5</b>	<b>HOPE</b> - Advent: waiting in the joyful hope for Jesus, the promised one
<b>Year 6</b>	<b>EXPECTATIONS</b> - Jesus born to show God to the world

## SUGGESTIONS FOR HOME ACTIVITIES

Discuss with the children how your family welcomes visitors to your home.

Find out about some Christian symbols for Advent e.g. Advent wreath, calendar, Jesse tree.
