

English

We will be basing our writing on the book 'Stone Age Boy'. We will be writing diary entries in the life of a stone age child, letters describing what life is like and instructions on how to do simple stone age skills. We will use The Croods and do some descriptive writing based on the animation.

PSHE

In term 1, we will be creating class rules and discussing our rights and responsibilities towards each other. In term 2, we will be learning how to keep safe.

Maths

We will be working hard to improve our accuracy with the four main operations; addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. As well as working on using and understanding place value, during CLIC (our mental arithmetic sessions), we will revisit previous knowledge before developing new skills.

RE

We are learning to investigate what happens during the festival of Divali and whether celebrations bring a sense of belonging to Hinus. We will then learn to understand the reasons why a Sikh may chose to join the Khalsa.

Stones and Bones

Science

We will be learning about the different parts of plants and their function and what different plants need to grow and survive. We will also compare and contrast different rocks and soils and understand the reasoning behind using different materials in different ways.

PE

Throughout term 1 and 2 we will have coaching with MLT, where we will be learning a range of ball skills. We will also be learning gymnastic skills.

Computing

We will start by learning how to stay safe online and then we will learn to use search engines and then use a programme called Scratch.

Topic

We will be exploring the Stone Age, comparing and contrasting life in the stone age to life today. We will look at how stone age civilisations lived their lives, how they used tools and what skills they needed to survive.

Music

We will be having recorder lessons every week.

Art/DT

Our artwork will be inspired the Stone Age; we will use different media to create cave paintings and develop our sketching skills by learning about different types of lead.

Being a Global Citizen

Throughout our topic we will look at early developments in settlements and civilisations and how these have led to changes in farming and livelihoods.

We will learn how to say simple greetings, numbers, days of the week and Christmas related vocabulary.
