**Please register for free meals if you're eligible!!!**

If you think you are eligible for free school meals (because you meet the criteria below) and you are not currently claiming for free school meals, we ask that you please register as the school will receive separate funding for pupils eligible for free school meals. You may qualify for free school meals if you receive one of the following benefits:

- Universal Credit with an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400
- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance (JSA)
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance (ESA)
- Support under Part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The Guarantee element of State Pension Credit
- Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for the four weeks after the person stops qualifying for Working Tax Credit)
- Child Tax Credit (with no Working Tax Credit) with an annual income of no more than £16,190
