Dear Parents

This week the children have settled in towards routines and expectations.

**English** – We have continued to work on character descriptions linked to the film, 'French Roast'. Children are finding different ways to spell a selection of words and we have started Guided Reading with an article about a herd of cows running loose in a small village.

**Maths** – The children have been rounding numbers and problem solving this week.

**Topic** – We have moved on to The Circulatory System and the children are researching the heart and how the blood is pumped through the body.

**JS** - We spoke about the mitzvah of Lulav and Etrog and explained that each one represents a different part of the human body. The children understood that each part of the body can be used to do Mitzvot and serve Hashem.

**Ivrit** -We started the topic "When I was Born" and we learnt the name of the Jewish months.

**Reminders** – *Please read with your children and sign the diary.*

The children must be reading their scheme books out loud every evening. Please ask them comprehension questions about the text they are reading and date and sign the blue diary each time. The children should also be reading their 'home' books as well. The school library books can be changed or renewed on Tuesdays or in Library Club on Wednesdays.

Please ensure your child has their blue diary each day. If they are being collected by someone else to usual, this must be recorded in the diary on the day.

All boys need a spare kippah in their tray and all children need a non-uniform cap in their tray too.
