Reading

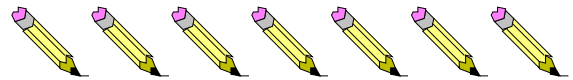
Please read with your child every day and discuss what has been read.



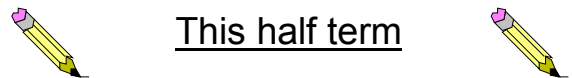
PE and Games
