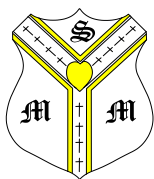

POLITE REMINDERS

- ♥ Before and after the school day, playground equipment, including the trim trails, traverse wall and football area is strictly off limits. This equipment must only be used when supervised by a member of school staff.
- ♥ Dogs are not allowed anywhere on the school grounds.
- ♥ Smoking, including e-cigarettes, are not allowed anywhere on the school grounds.
- ♥ It is wonderful to see children riding bikes and scooters on the school grounds and these can be stored in the cycle racks next to the Year 1 door. We ask that when children enter the playground they walk with, rather than ride, their bikes and scooters.
- ♥ We ask that mobile phones are not used anywhere in the school grounds or in the school building. This is in accordance with safeguarding.
