

SEASONAL FLU NASAL VACCINATION PROGRAMME

All pupils from Reception to Year 5 are eligible to receive an influenza vaccine. Forms were recently sent home to give parents the option of accepting or refusing the offer of their child receiving the vaccine.

If you wish your child to have the flu vaccination – which is administered through a simple spray of the vaccine into the child's nostrils – and have not yet returned the consent form, please do so as soon as possible otherwise your child may not receive it.

Intra Health who are the organisation responsible for the flu vaccination programme in schools will be sending their staff into school on Friday 5th October to administer the vaccine to those children whose parents have requested it.

CONSENT AND DATA COLLECTION FORMS – IMPORTANT NOTICE:

Thank you to the very large majority of parents who have returned these forms to school. However there are a small number of children whose forms have not yet been returned to school. **It is essential that the information requested is received by the school office and any outstanding forms must now be returned to school at the start of next week.** If the form has been lost please visit the school office to collect another one.
