

School Attendance

The **minimum attendance** level which is expected for all primary aged children **nationally** is **96%**. Good attendance is very important so that children are given as much opportunity as possible to develop academically and socially. To keep parents informed about their child's attendance, letters & attendance sheets were sent home this week about the academic year 2017-2018;

Green letter = 96%+ attendance

Yellow Letter = 92-95% attendance

Red Letter = <92% attendance

Congratulations to every child who got a GREEN letter - this is FANTASTIC!

Thank you to parents & carers for your co-operation in this important matter.

For those children with exceptional attendance (99%+) Bronze, Silver & Gold Attendance certificates were presented in Friday's worship.
