

Maths – We are going to:

Practise one to one correspondence, counting objects to 10 and beyond.

Practise reading and writing numerals to at least 10.

Encourage the children to find the number that matches the amount of objects in a set.

Ask the children to compare groups of objects saying which group has more and which has less.

Literacy – We are going to:

Share familiar and new stories that help the children talk about themselves: their family, likes, dislikes and what makes them unique.

Read traditional tales such as The Three Billy Goats Gruff, The Three Little Pigs, Goldilocks and the Three Bears.

Introduce children to phonics, learning the sounds for letters of the alphabet.

Encourage children to use the sounds they are learning to identify the first sound in a word, for example, b – bus.

Help the children recognise their name and practise writing it using the correct letter formation.

Communication and Language – We are going to:

Have daily small group activities where children can share news and talk to their friends about stories they like and things they are interested in.

Write about the children's different experiences from home and school.

Understanding the World – We are going to:

Look at and explore the changes that happen around us as the environment changes in the Autumn season.

Talk about the way we celebrate special events such as Eid, birthdays, Halloween and Bonfire Night.

Physical Development – We are going to:

Encourage the children to practise skills that will help them with early writing and using small tools, such as cutting, threading and playdough.

Explore the climbing equipment and building blocks outdoors to develop the children's balance, control and coordination.

Expressive Art and Design – We are going to:

Encourage the children to plan what they would like to make and to think about the resources and tools they will need.

Provide opportunities for the children to act out stories or experiences through role-play with their friends.

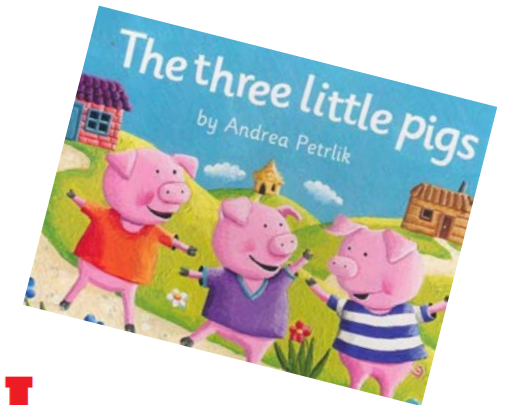
P.E. will be **Friday morning**. Your child will need their PE kit – T-shirt, shorts and plimsolls please.
