- To ensure all children are provided with a range of extra curriculum and enrichment activities.

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Type of Support Provided by PP – 2017-2018

Curriculum Support

In class, intervention and 1:1 support is provided.

Purchase of IDL dyslexia support programme.

Analysis of PP pupils results from assessments leading to targeted support and improved communication with parents about how they are being helped.

Extra Curricular Activities

Children from disadvantaged backgrounds are supported with funding for undertaking activities from which they will benefit.

Curriculum Support Provided by PP – 2017-2018

1:1 and small group support is given every morning.

IDL dyslexia support programme purchased to help children with spelling difficulties.

Reinforcement support during and after class teaching.

Impact of Plan
Termly analysis was carried out to assess progress of interventions for children with PP. A programme of interventions was established and TA timetables were focused on PP children who needed extra support. IDL support programme successfully implemented and additional support programmes for maths, reading and spelling purchased. These have had a substantial impact on the children involved.
