As a school, we aim to safeguard and protect our pupils. All staff have had safeguarding and child protection training. In school we have five members of staff who have specialist training and are the school's Designated Safeguarding Leads. It is important that you telephone the school office before 9.30am to inform them about any absence. The Government does not allow holidays in term-time.
