Remembrance



On the afternoon of Monday 8th October KS2 will be working at Cracoe Village Hall with children from the cluster schools on a range of workshops in preparation for a WW1 Remembrance service, which will be held at Linton Church on Friday 9th November. Children will be transported by Jacksons and will return for 3.30pm. There is no charge for the workshop but a contribution towards transport of £5 would be appreciated when it has been added to Parentpay.

Spelling

The spelling programme we use for children from Y2 to Y6 has been carefully selected to make sure children build on the phonics taught in reception and Y1. It fully embeds both phonic patterns and high frequency words and helps children to develop a fluent, joined handwriting style. Spelling tests are given in the form of a story dictation which incorporates previous weeks' spellings and high frequency words and develops punctuation skills. Please encourage your children to practise their spellings in joined handwriting, even if they think they know them, as this will enable them to move on smoothly to the more complex words and patterns later in the year. If you want to give your children 'harder' spellings the days of the week, months of the year, words with apostrophes, names, countries etc are always useful to know. If you require any further information about spelling please speak to Mrs Addy.

The Children's Bookshow

On Tuesday 2nd October Yr 1,2 and 3 children will be going to The Children's Bookshow at the Kings Hall in Ilkley to see Victoria Semykina, a Russian illustrator of a new book for children called *The Real Boat*.

From Performance information: "*Victoria will be talking about her life and work as an illustrator. She will show the children how she creates pictures to go with the words, and what inspired her to become an illustrator in the first place. Children will love watching Victoria draw live on stage and playing fun and interactive guessing games as she draws for them. She will be joined on stage by actor Samuel John who will read aloud The Real Boat and bring the story to life as the children look at Victoria's illustrations on a large screen.*"

Children will be given a copy each of *The Real Boat* (RRP £14.99) to take home and Victoria will then come into school the following day to do a workshop directly with the children.

They will be transported by Jacksons of Silsden. Costs for transport and the show work out at £14.00 each so contributions of at least £10 each would be appreciated once the visit has been added to Parentpay.
