Description

Exam board: Edexcel

There are four topics covered, all of which are assessed through exams in the summer of Year 11.

Exam papers

Paper 1: Thematic Study (Medicine through Time, 1250-present) + Historic Environment (The British Sector of the Western Front, 1914-1918: injuries, treatment and the trenches). 1 hour 15 minutes, 30% of the GCSE.

Paper 2: Period Study (Superpower Relations and the Cold War, 1941-1991) + British Depth Study (Early Elizabethan England, 1558-1588). 1 hour 45 minutes, 40% of the GCSE.

Paper 3: Modern Depth Study (Russia and the Soviet Union, 1917-1941). 1 hour 20 minutes, 30% of the GCSE.

Early Elizabethan England

This is the British Depth Study. All three exam questions will focus on knowledge. It covers three key topics, which are:

Key Topic 1: Queen, government and religion, 1558-1569

Key Topic 2: Challenges to Elizabeth at home and abroad, 1569-1588

Key Topic 3: Elizabethan Society in the Age of Exploration, 1558-1588

Medicine Through Time:

This is the Thematic Study. It focuses on ideas about cause of disease and illness, approaches to prevention and treatment, and seven different case studies. All three exam questions will focus on knowledge. The topic covers four key topics, which are:

Key Topic 1: Medicine in Medieval England, 1250-1500; Case Study: the Black Death (1348-49).

Key Topic 2: The Medical Renaissance in England, 1500-1700; Case Studies: William Harvey and the circulation of blood, Dealing with the Great Plague (1665).

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Key Topic 3: Medicine in 18th and 19th century Britain, 1700-1900; Case Studies: Jenner and the development of vaccination, Fighting Cholera in London (1854).

Key Topic 4: Medicine in modern Britain, 1900-present; Case Studies: Fleming, Florey and Chain's development of Penicillin, The fight against Lung Cancer in the 21st century.

The British Sector of the Western Front:

This is the Historic Environment. It fits into the overall theme of 'Medicine Through Time', but covers this specific time period in much more detail. In the exam, pupils will be asked one 'knowledge' question and two 'source-based' questions.

Russia and the Soviet Union

This is the Modern Depth Study. It requires pupils to understand the changes in Russia, from 1917 to 1941, in a lot of detail. The six exam questions will focus on sources, knowledge and historical interpretations. There are four key topics, which are:

Key Topic 1: The revolutions of 1917

Key Topic 2: The Bolsheviks in power, 1917-24

Key Topic 3: Stalin's rise to power and dictatorship, 1924-41

Key Topic 4: Economic and social changes, 1924-1941
