



# Year 1 Phonics, Reading and Learning at Home

Phonics - Learning the new phonemes / graphemes will begin straight away. New phoneme sounds and actions will come home on a Friday. These are to be completed at home and keep at home. Either put them on the fridge, wardrobe or make a book out of them to refer back to.

Reading - We aim to hear children read once a week where possible. Books are changed every Friday but also when needed. Please look at and discuss the pictures, spot phonemes / graphemes and talk about the story and characters. Children can also be encouraged to read other books at home and will enjoy listening to stories being read to them.

Common words - Your child will bring home a set of flashcards. They will see these words all the time in their reading and will use them in their writing. Children will need to be able to read and spell them correctly as they will be monitored throughout each term.

Maths- Children can be encouraged to read, write and count numbers to 100.
