Literacy

Our Literacy this week has continued to focus on listening and attention skills. We have introduced some of the Makaton signs we learnt last week and the children have been adding them to our new 'Good Morning' song from last week. They have also had a go at signing what their names are. Our sound of the week has been the letter 'a'.

Maths

Our Maths sessions have continued to look at the children's knowledge of colour and numbers and they have been naming, sorting and counting different coloured objects in the classroom. They have also been singing counting songs and thought about simple 2D shapes.

Topic

In our topic work, the children have investigated some of the signs of autumn such as leaves, conkers and pinecones. They have started to create a rainbow collage for the corridor and drawn pictures of their families for our classroom display.
