Data arising from the summer term tests will be published soon but in the meantime:

©63 families returned the questionnaires and 100% think that the school is well-led, inclusive, progressive and welcoming

©Early Years: 72% of children achieved a "Good Level of Development"

©Yr 1: 75% of children & 83% of children in Yr 2, achieved age-related expectations in Phonics

©Yr 2: 67% children achieved age-related expectations in Reading & Writing. 64% children achieved age-related expectations in Maths

©Yr 6: 80% children achieved age-related expectations in Reading & Writing. 73% children achieved age-related expectations in Maths

## Flu Vaccinations

An electronic consent process for nasal flu vaccinations has been created by the school nursing team.

Later this term, we will share a link via text, Facebook and email that will enable consent to be given without need for a pen! With a computer or smart phone, families can use the link to connect to a secure website to complete all details required for consent. There may be some families for whom this process may not be possible and in this circumstance, we can provide a paper consent.

Vaccinations are planned for 9th November so there is plenty of time to address any queries. Julie Puzdrowski, our Family Link Partner, is very happy to work alongside families who might value some support with this process—just let her know.
