Parents Questionnaire

We received a reassuring response to our questions. In your opinion, 95% felt safe in school with 91% feeling happy. 97% of parents felt that their children received an education within their ability and 100% felt that 'Headsprout' was beneficial to their children. The children's questionnaire showed similar results with 96% saying that they felt happy and safe in school and 88% stated that they felt they were being treated fairly.
