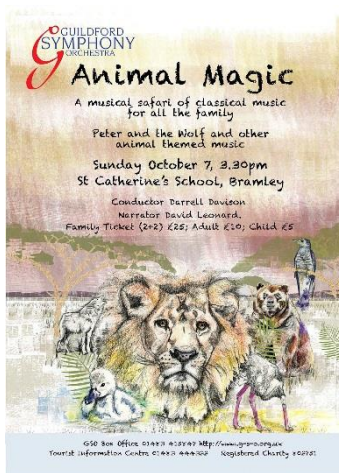
International School Award 2018-2021
