Dear Parents/Carers,

We have had a really busy week in school. Year 3 had a fascinating day out at Stonehenge and really enjoyed the workshops. I had the pleasure of not only teaching Year 5 science but also taking Year 2 to the Seacity Museum. We had a great day out and it really put the learning in the classroom into context.

This week I also had the opportunity to formally observe the teachers and their classes. I was really impressed with the variety of teaching and learning that I saw. The children were engaged and lessons were purposeful.

As discussed at the 'Ofsted' meeting we had the first of our new 'Parent Focus Group' meetings. We discussed in length 'Parents' evening' and how both the school and the parents would like these to run. I will send a more detailed letter next week with the outcomes of this meeting. We also agreed to meet again on 28th November 2018 at 6.00p.m. Currently we have 7 members of the groups so if you would like to join please let the office know.

Another area that was highlighted at the meeting was to address boys' achievement. Morgan's Vale School have organised a workshop with an inspirational teacher, who now works with schools to raise boy's achievement, called Gary Wilson. Our staff will be attending a session with him but he is also offering a workshop for parents which you are all invited – please see the next page for details.

On a more serious note, we have had a number of serious concerns from members of the public about road safety at both sites. At KS2 children are walking up to the green and at times are not being sensible on the road, and at KS1 children are sometimes unsupervised and parking is at times inconsiderate. We will be having assemblies at school next week discussing road safety with the children but we would ask parents to also have serious conversations with their children to ensure they are safe when they leave the school grounds. I will endeavour to be outside at school pick up to monitor this but as I am sure you are aware this will not always be possible.

On a happier note the Year5/6 Girls football team came third in the Schools Games Primary Football festival which was brilliant – well done to all of the girls who took part and thank you to Mrs. Hayward for coaching them.

We would like to send our very best wishes to Mrs Perry and her husband. Mrs Perry will be starting her maternity cover today and we are all very excited for them and their future family.

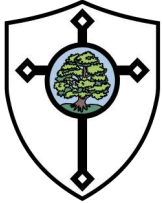

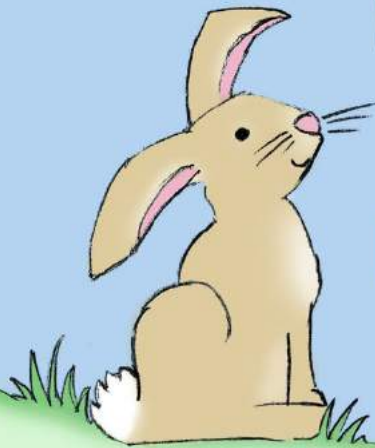
