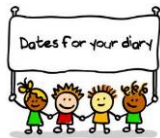

Keep the children occupied during the Autumn holidays with a range of activities at Jigsaws Childcare in Church Fenton. Our 'holiday' club offers a safe, caring and fun environment for your child, while our range of half term activities will give them lots to enjoy, a chance to meet new friends and learn new skills.

Activity sessions run from 9.30am to 11.30am and cost £8 per session. * There is an extra £2.50 charge to use the woodland for each Forest Schools sessions. If you have not used Jigsaws before, we would need you to complete a record form when booking. Payment for booked activities is expected before the first activity to secure places and ensure the correct ratios of staff to children.

Customers using our usual sessions do not need to book for the activities – your child/ren will be involved automatically. Please note if you have a funded 3-4 year old using our holiday sessions a payment of £3 per activity is required to cover costs.
