Dear Parents and Carers,

Please see below our school notices:-

- We would like to remind you of the **48 hour rule** with regard to **vomiting and diarrhoea**. If your child has had either of these symptoms they need to be off school for 48 hours after the final episode.
- We are aware that there have been occasions this term when some children have missed out on their choice of puddings and bread at lunch times due to their classes being the final ones to have school lunch. As you may be aware a new catering company started in September and sadly there have been incidences where they have not catered correctly with regard to puddings and bread. We completely agree that this should not be happening and we have had several meetings this week with the management of **Caterlink**, including them coming into school during lunchtimes to support the catering team. We have been assured that this will not continue to happen (extra experienced staff have been drafted in). As a school we will continue to be vigilant in observing lunchtimes to ensure this does not continue. We will make further updates in the forthcoming weeks to share how this is progressing.
- We will be sending home **Data Collection Sheets** for each child showing their details and emergency contact details. Please will you check the sheet, carry out any amendments and return to the school office as soon as possible so that we can make any necessary changes on our system.

- **Flu immunisations** are taking place on Tuesday for children who have returned their consent forms.
