Science: Animals inc. humans


In this unit children learn about human and animal bodies and consider similarities and differences between them. Children will engage in a variety of activities including drawing and labelling the human body, exploring the five senses, describing animal bodies and sorting animals into groups e.g. according to their diet. They will learn the difference between carnivores, herbivores and omnivores. They will gather and record information and use it to ask and answer questions.
