- Please can drinks bottles not be placed in book bags.

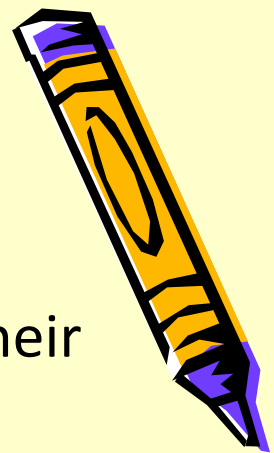


End of the day

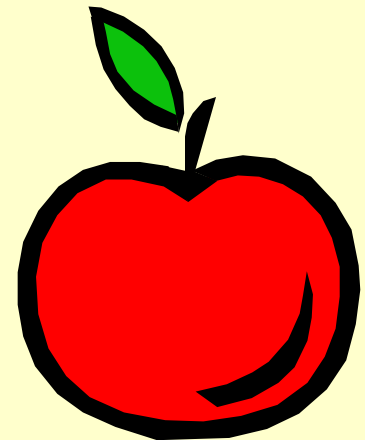

Daily routine



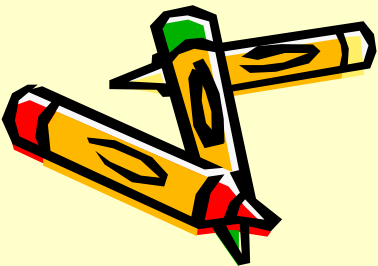
- We will start our day at 9am with phonics where children will be sorted in to smaller learning groups.

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

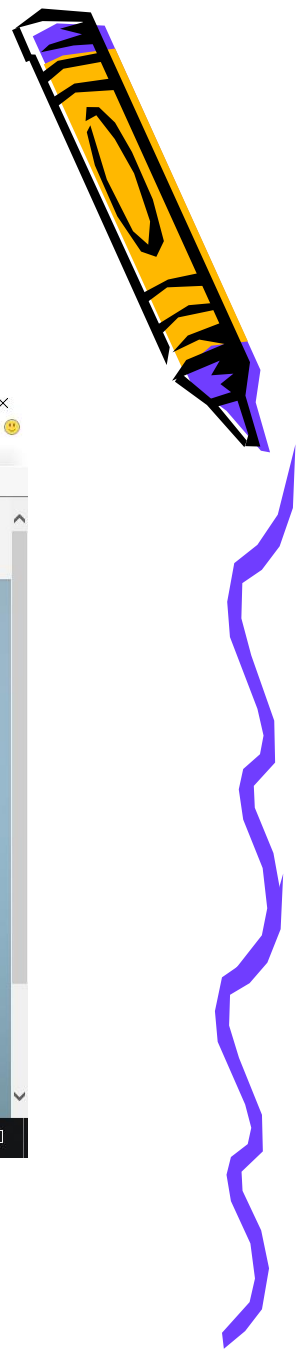

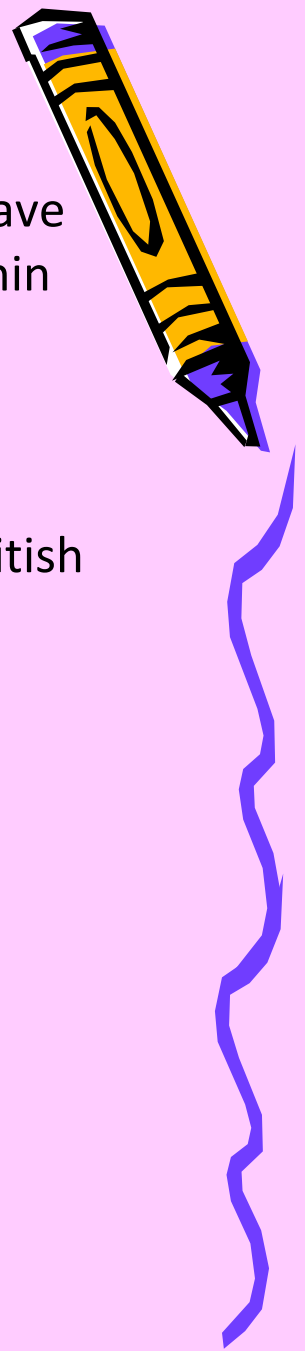
