I am pleased to list below some of your comments on what you felt we do really well as a school.

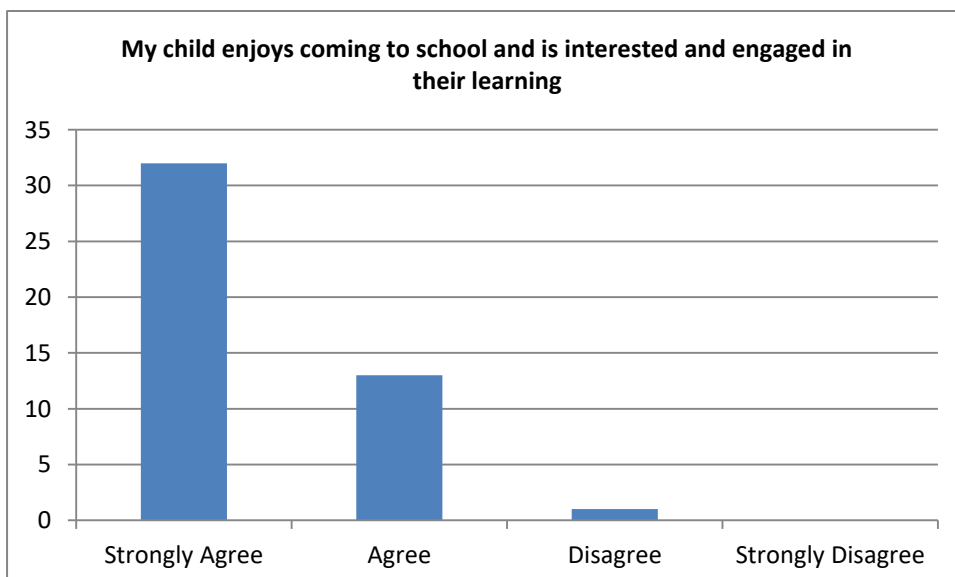
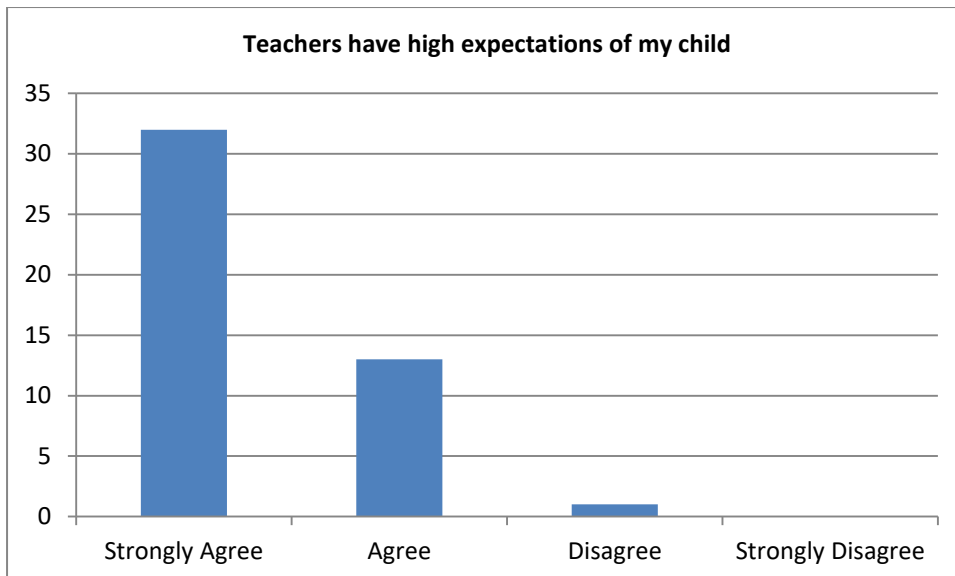
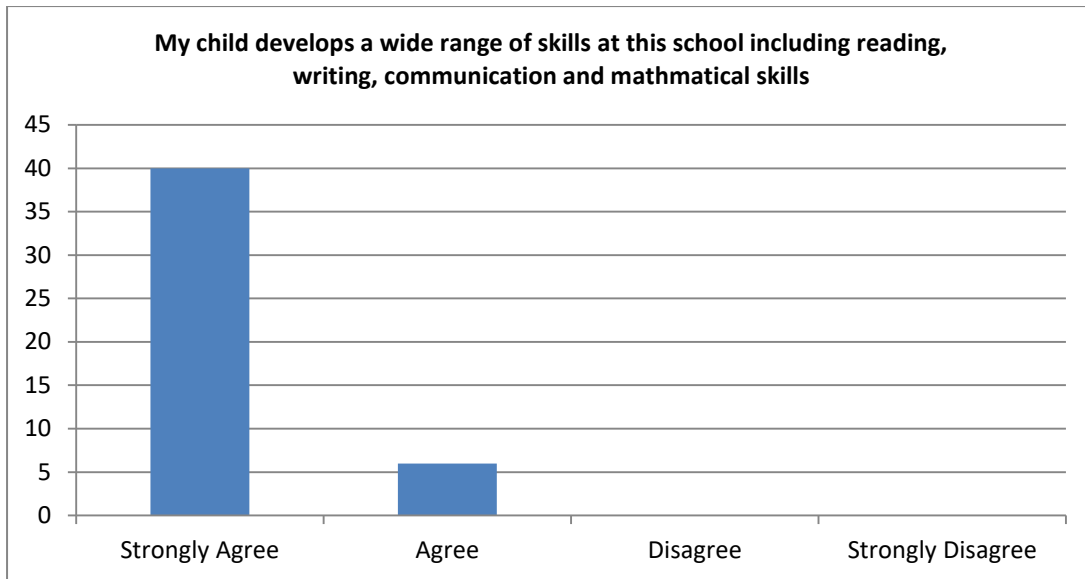
1. We provide good attention to detail regarding family and personal circumstances.

14. We have good communication with parents.

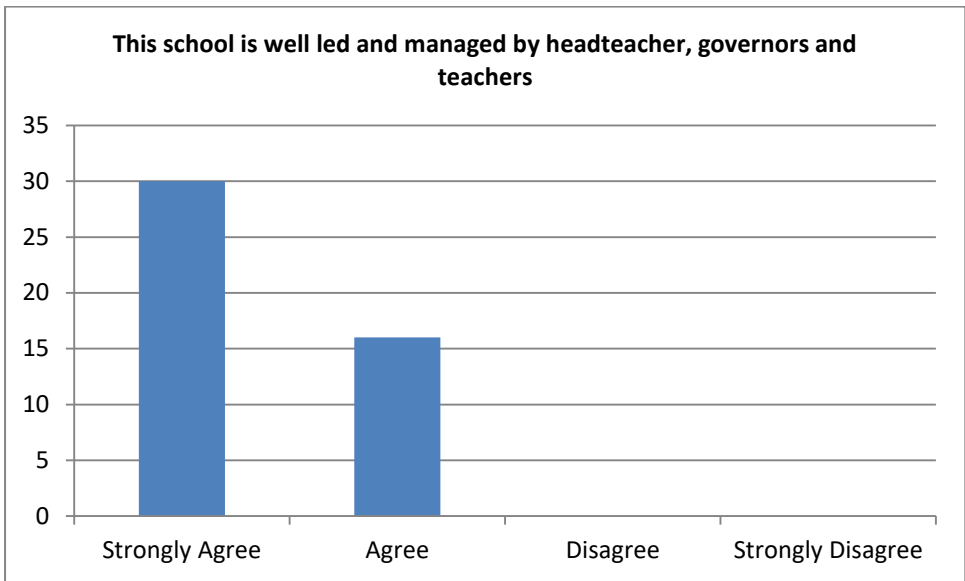
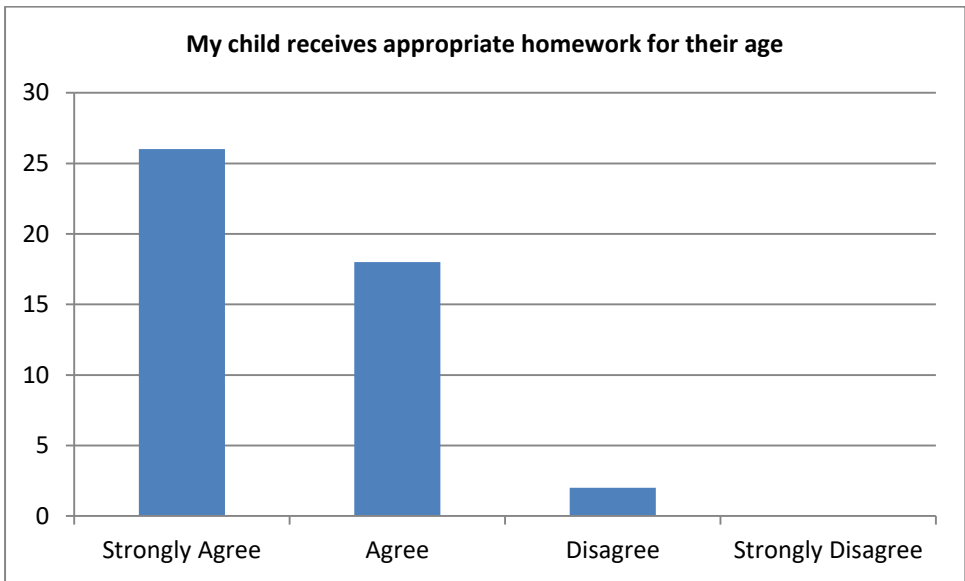
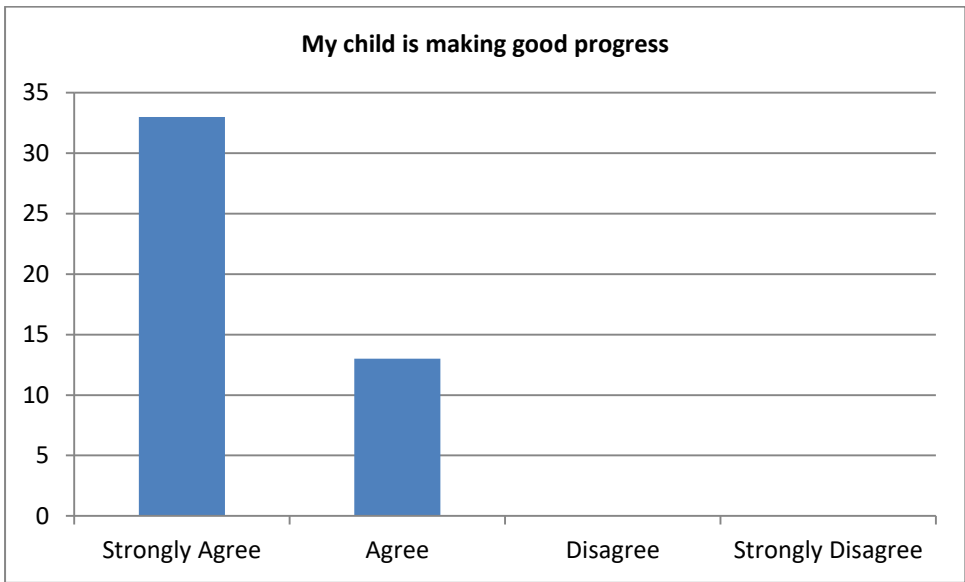
We have strong links with the church and families.

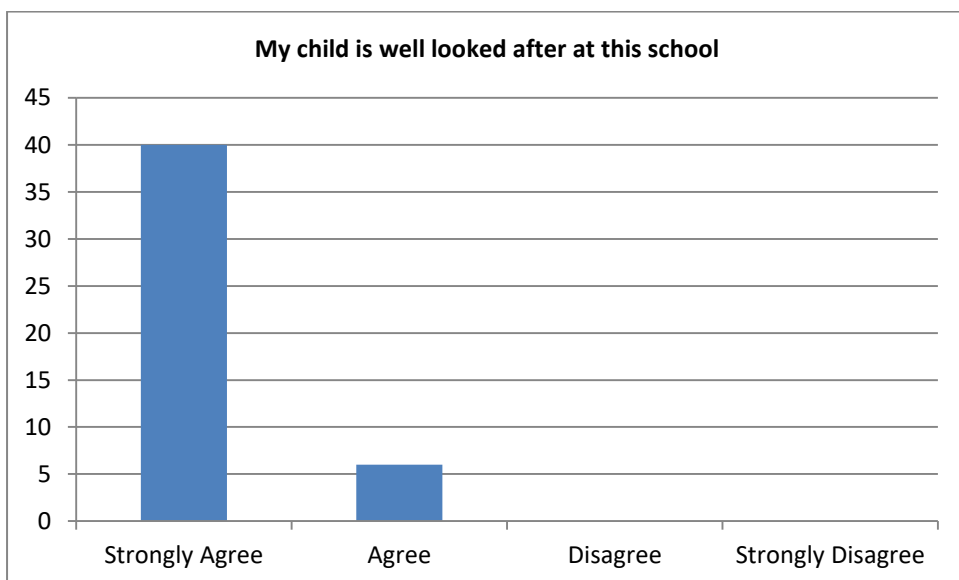
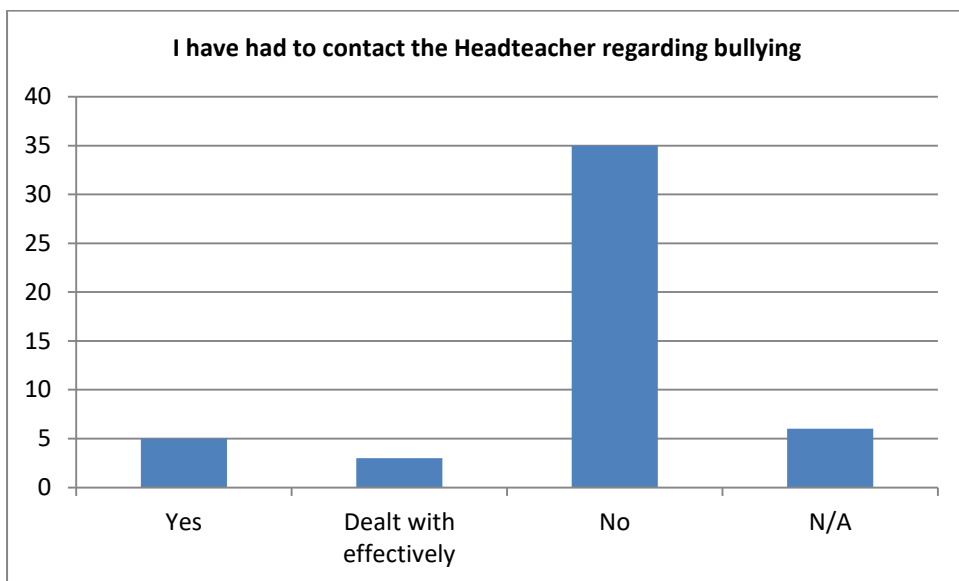
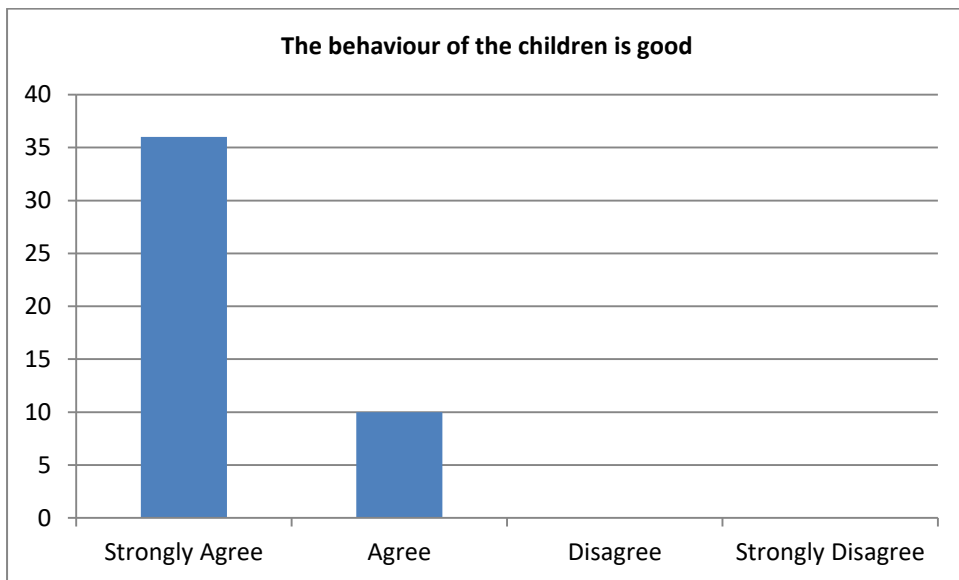
Some of the areas you feel we need to focus on:

1. Teachers have high expectations of my child.	One parent expressed that the teachers do not have high expectations of their child. Targets are shared with parents at consultation day and the school has an open door policy where parents can make an appointment to discuss the expectations the teachers have for their child/ren.
2. My child receives appropriate homework for their age.	Some parents still disagree that their child receives age appropriate homework. The school has continued to address this issue by introducing project books and revision guides for our year 6 pupils. The school also sent out information regarding alternative homework providers. As an alternative approach to homework, the school will be sending some thematic projects home for the children to complete later in the year.

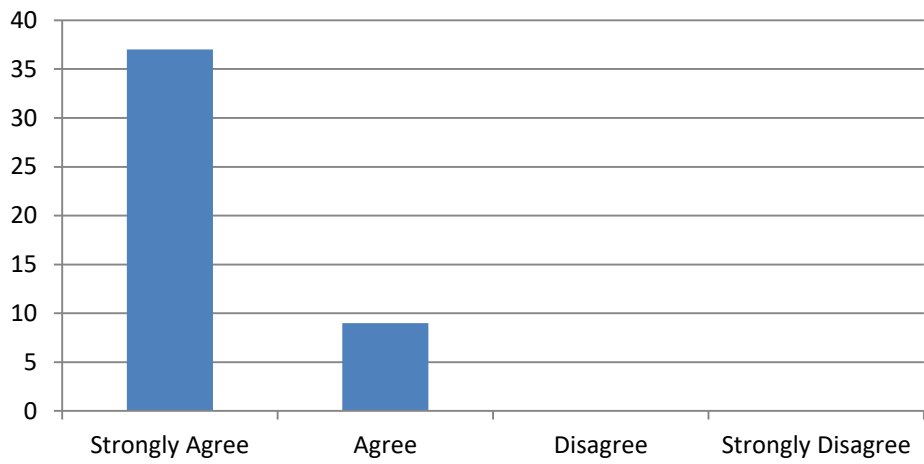
