E.g. <i>The Gruffalo's Child</i>, <i>What the Ladybird Heard</i>, <i>Monkey Puzzle</i></p>	<p>Dinnertime</p> <p>Can you make a bird feeder for the birds to enjoy this winter for your garden? Take a photograph to share with your friends. What type of things do you think they would like to eat?</p> 	<p>Hibernating</p> <p>Can you build a home for an animal to keep warm and hibernate in this winter? Can you take a photograph and stick it in your homework book?</p>	<p>My favourite things</p> <p>At home collect 4 favourite things that you can use to tell your class about yourself. Include a photograph of you and your family. Bring your bag to school on 17th September to share with your class. We can't wait to learn all about you!</p>

Can you record any of the numbers that you see in your book?</p>	<p>Let's go shopping</p> <p>Can you visit the shops with your family? Think about:- What will you buy? How much money will you need? Will you get any change? Can you bring in your receipt to show what you bought and how much you spent?</p>	<p>Repeating Patterns</p> <p>Can you see any patterns in your house? What could you use in your house to create your own repeating pattern? E.g. Beads, biscuits, pasta.</p>
	<p>Diwali</p> <p>Can you help your family to prepare and make some Indian food? Curry, samosa, mango chutney etc. Would you like to bring them in for your friends to try?</p>	<p>Nativity</p>  <p>Can you find out about the story of Christmas? How can you retell the story? Story map, puppets, role play.</p>	<p>Christmas</p> <p>Can you write a Christmas wish list to send to Father Christmas?
