SUPPORTING PUPILS WITH MEDICAL CONDITIONS

Reviewed October 2017 – Ratified 7th November 2017

Rationale

- Pupils with medical conditions should be properly supported at school to enable them to have full access to education, including trips and PE

Statement of Intent

- To ensure that arrangements are in place to support pupils based on their individual medical conditions
- To liaise effectively with health and social care professionals to ensure the effective support and understanding of the individual medical conditions

Strategies

- The SENDCo will be responsible for ensuring that designated staff are suitably trained and kept up to date about children with medical conditions
- The medical needs of pupils will be communicated to staff and parents where necessary
- Care plans will be made available to all relevant staff and shared with supply staff if and when needed
- The schools will work in partnership between staff, pupil, parents/carers and healthcare professionals regularly
- Medicines should be stored safely and all relevant staff should know where to find medicines for particular pupils

Frequency - Annually
