Performance 2015-2017

The tables below represent the performance of the Year 6, Year 2, Year 1 and Reception children in the national performance tests (SATs etc.) in July 2017, 2016 and 2015. The children and their teachers are to be congratulated again this year on both the standards reached and the progress made by everyone. It has been a different challenge because, of course, the children have been tested on the new National Curriculum again this year. It is possible to compare last years' results with 2017, however the criteria for progress remains challenging because the current Year 6 had their attainment measured in Levels at the end of Key Stage1 (level 1, 2, 3) etc. on the old curriculum and now it is measured in marks (points and scaled scores) on the new curriculum. In 2018 the cohort of children leaving Year 6 will be the first group of children to go through from Reception to Y6 studying the new National Curriculum and so the results should show a more accurate check on both attainment and progress.

Key Stage 2 Attainment

This year the school has again received a letter from The Rt Honorable Nick Gibb, MP, Minister of State for School Standards, congratulating the staff and pupils on the very high standards that were achieved by the Year 6 pupils: 100%* of them reached the expected standard in Maths and Reading their scores putting the school in **the top 1% of schools in the country**.

2016 and 2017 Progress is calculated by the difference in point scores between KS1 and KS2 Progress of 0.0 is average progress for children in schools with similar starting points; positive (+points) sch. average is above expected progress; negative (- points) sch. average is below expected.

Progress score, description.

These scores show how much progress pupils at Foxmoor made in reading, writing and maths between the end of Key Stage 1 and the end of Key Stage 2, and compares their progress results with those of the children Nationally, and those of the children in Gloucestershire (the Local Authority) and 'Schools like us'.

The progress scores are calculated Nationally by comparing the Key Stage 2 test and assessment results of pupils with their assessment results at the end of the previous Key Stage (Key Stage 1).

The 'Schools like us' category are schools who got similar assessment results at the end of Key Stage 1, and Foxmoor children's progress is also compared with them.

A score above zero means pupils made more progress, on average, than pupils across England who got similar results at the end of Key Stage 1.

A score below zero means pupils made less progress, on average, than pupils across England who got similar results at the end of Key Stage 1.
