The following packed products are suitable for offering to the local foodbank for redistribution to families in need or homeless people:

Tinned meats: ham, luncheon meat, corned beef, etc

Tinned fish: tuna, mackerel, pilchards, etc

Tinned vegetables: potatoes, carrots, peas, baked beans, tomatoes, etc

Tinned pasta and spaghetti

Tinned soups

Tinned fruit: peaches, pears, fruit salad, etc

Tinned milk and custard

Powdered milk

Breakfast cereals

Packet soups

Packets of pasta

Tea bags, instant coffee, sugar

*Please note: Where possible tins with ring pull opening are most suitable.
All products should be chosen with a long shelf life.*
