### Flu Immunisation Programme

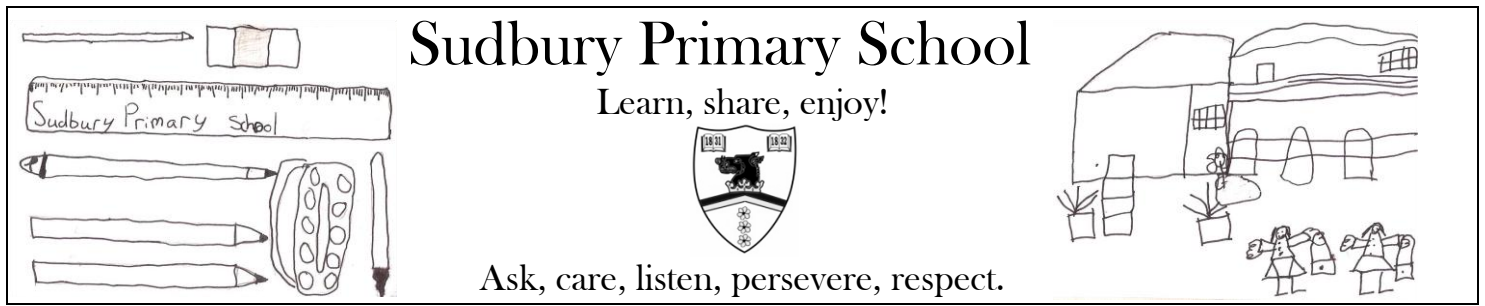

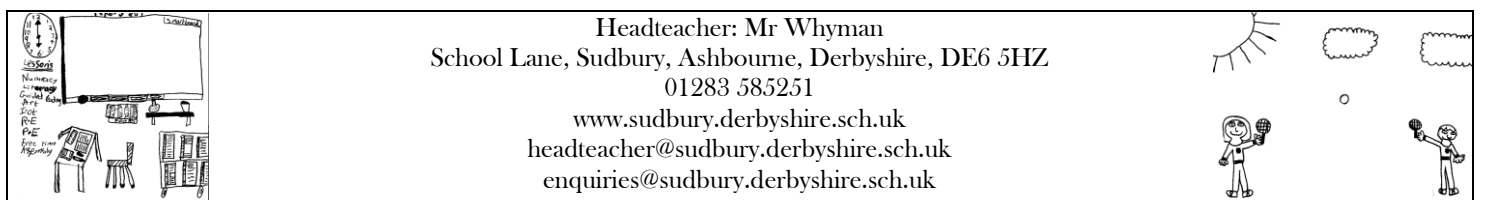
## School Website
