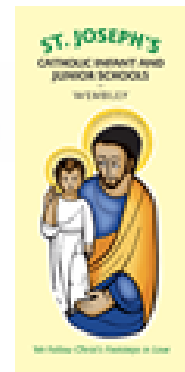
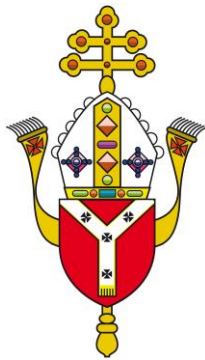
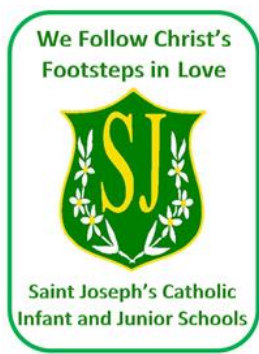

### **Main Barriers to Educational Achievement faced by eligible pupils at St. Joseph's Junior School:**

- PP pupils who are also SEND making adequate progress.
- PP pupils end of key stage school attainment was lower in reading and mathematics at greater depth.
- Lower socio economic background by the majority of these pupils.
- Financial difficulty in funding extended day and trip opportunities.

### **: How funds will be spent to address these barriers and the predicted impact of this approach**

### **Pupil Premium Statement 2018-19**

The Pupil Premium grant was introduced in April 2011. In 2018-19 schools were allocated £1,320 per pupil for children from low-income families who were eligible for free school meals and £1,900 per pupil for 'looked-after' children.

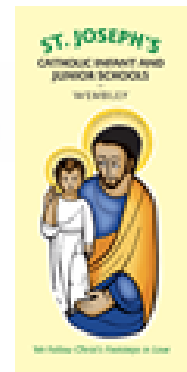
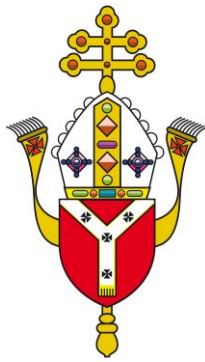
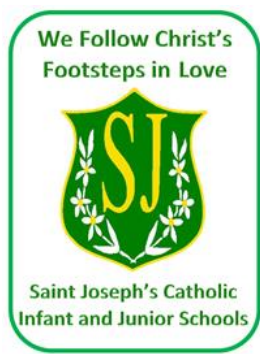
The Pupil Premium grant is used to provide additional support in order to improve the progress and to raise the standard of achievement for eligible pupils.

The funding issued is to narrow and close the gap between the achievement of these pupils and their peers. Where necessary and where we have the capacity to do so the school will use additional funding to address any underlying inequalities between children eligible for Pupil Premium funding and others. This will vary depending on the individual circumstances and needs of the child.

### **Priorities for 2018– 2019**

- Reading comprehension across the school
- Writing attainment across the school, particularly greater depth writers
- Mathematics – developing pupil reasoning skills

Additional support will continue to be offered to individual children based on the individual needs and circumstances of the child, and will be tailored accordingly following close monitoring of each Pupil premium pupil.

## **Ongoing strategies**

### **RE**

\*Booster groups: this is provided for pupils to support them in narrowing and closing the gap between them and their peers \*Targeted homework club

### **Literacy**

\*Booster groups: this is provided for pupils to support them in narrowing and closing the gap between them and their peers \*Phonics groups \*Daily one to one reading \*EAL groups  
\*Homework support group \*Lexia reading program

### **Numeracy**

\*Booster groups this is provided for pupils to support them in narrowing and closing the gap between them and their peers \*Setting \*Access to Mathletics \*Homework support group

### **Wellbeing/social & emotional**

Financial support for trips, residential journeys and clubs. Where appropriate, students are given financial support to attend class trips, residential journeys and attend clubs including breakfast and after school club as well as support with the purchase of school uniform if required.
