- toiletries



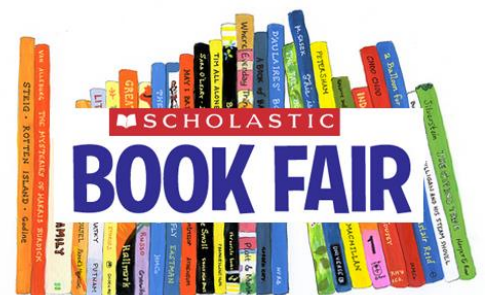
