PARKING: PARENTS ARE PUTTING THE LIVES OF OUR CHILDREN AT RISK

Dear Parents & Carers,

As most of you are aware, each morning and afternoon you will find a member of staff at the gates to welcome our school community and to ensure the safety of everyone.

We have only been back in school for a month and we have already had a near miss with a child nearly knocked down by a car which was driving at speed and without due care or attention.

Please remember...

- Cars should NOT STOP or PARK on the yellow zig-zag lines, directly outside school in the D area, BETWEEN 8.00am-9.30am AND 2.30-pm-4.30am for the safety of our children.
- Cars should NOT PARK on the double yellow lines on Spencer Road or the neighbouring streets.
- Cars should NOT be blocking residents' driveways, even if the driver remains in the car, to help us maintain positive relationships with our neighbours.
- Cars should NOT be parked in residents' driveways
- Verbal abuse towards staff will NOT be tolerated. The staff are out on duty to ensure the safety of all our pupils at Byron Court.
- Verbal abuse towards residents will NOT be tolerated.
- Drivers should SLOW DOWN when driving on Spencer Road.

When parents ignore these simple rules they **PUT CHILDREN'S LIVES AT RISK!** It is hard to teach children that rules need to be followed in school when they see their own families and other adults breaking rules every day! Please be a positive role model for all our children at Byron Court.

We are now reporting inconsiderate parking and abusive incidents to the local police and are working closely with them and the local residents to ensure the safety of our children.

Free parking is available in Northwick Park Car Park, at the bottom of the Fairway, at the beginning and end of the school day. We encourage all members of the school community to use this facility.

By working in partnership together we can all help to keep our children safe!
