Re-Start a Heart Day

We have been lucky enough to be joining other schools across the East Midlands who have been selected to provide their pupils with life-saving Cardio Pulmonary

Resuscitation (CPR) training on Tuesday 16th October. Our children will be among 10,000 children across East Midlands who will be taking part in the world's largest event of its kind. Along with colleagues in other ambulance services the aim is to train 200,000 youngsters nationally. Two volunteers from the ambulance service will come to school on 16th October and will talk to the children about CPR, demonstrate how to do it and the children will have the opportunity to have a go. We can't wait to start a new generation of life savers and are really pleased that we have been chosen to take part.
