Family Worship

Every Friday, parents and carers are invited into school for Family Worship, we have two different Worships due to hall space. At 9.05am, KS1 parents/carers (Year 1, Year 2 parents) are able to enter school via the hall door but exit via the hall doors internally (escorted) due to PE lessons taking place on the field and the gates being locked and at 2.30pm. KS2 parents enter via the main office at 2.30pm prompt. We text parents to inform you if your child is going to receive a certificate but any parent/carer is welcome to Family Worship each week even if your child is not receiving a certificate.

Worship is a quiet and reflective time for our children. **We ask that parents are respectful and quiet during this Celebration Worship also,** please ensure your mobile phone is turned off or on silent. Parents arriving late will not be allowed to enter. If very young children attend, please sit near a door so that they can be taken out if they become noisy. Thank you for your understanding.

Thank you to all of the parents who have purchased black shoes or all black trainers for their children. Any child not in school shoes will be asked to change into a pair of black pumps. Children are looking smarter. ☺
