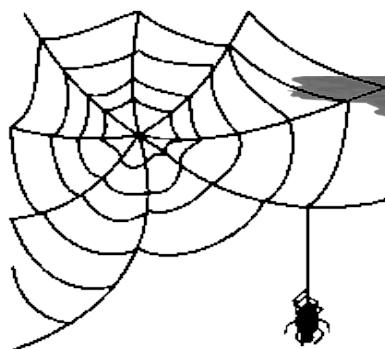


HALLOWE'EN DISCO!

Our Hallowe'en Disco is on **Wednesday 17th October!** There will be Hallowe'en music, fun and dancing and children can wear a fancy dress costume to school! We are running two discos – one for Reception and Year One and a separate one for Years 2 - 6 (Nursery are not able to join in due to Health and Safety).

RECEPTION AND YEAR 1 DISCO: 3.10pm – 4.00pm

Our infant disco will be held in the Nursery straight after school from 3.10pm until 4.00pm (please collect PROMPTLY from the infant lower playground outside the Nursery doors. There will be music, dancing, temporary tattoos and Halloween colouring! The cost for this disco will be £3.00 per child. Children will receive a snack of a biscuit and juice.

YEARS 2, 3, 4, 5, & 6 DISCO: 3.15pm – 4.30pm

Our Year 2 - 6 disco is from 3.15 – 4.30pm (please collect from the junior playground, outside the hall). There will be dancing, competitions and temporary tattoos! There will also be a quiet room so that children can have some time away from the noise and excitement if they choose to. The cost for this disco will be £3.00 per child. This disco will include a snack of a biscuit and drink.

COST: £3.00 per child

Year 6: please note that this is your swimming day! Children can still come in costume that day but bring their facepaints etc and children will be able to apply them at lunchtime.

All proceeds will go towards raising funds for school events. Wear your favourite ghoulish costume to school on 17th October (even if you aren't attending the disco for a small donation!)
