English

This week, we will be focussing on the following objectives through writing up a science experiment:

- ☺ Use imperative [bossy] verbs and time adverbials to make instructions clear.
- ☺ Use conjunctions to extend sentences.
- ☺ Include different types of sentences; e.g. questions, statements.
- ☺ Punctuate sentences correctly.
- ☺ Form letters correctly, using appropriate spaces between words.



Spelling Rule:

- ☺ If a word ends in a consonant +y, we **swap** the y for an i before adding **-ed**.

cry → cried

reply → replied

hurry → hurried

- ☺ Tricky words; please practice these words as much as possible and in sentences.

school, some, there, they, today, was, were, where, you, your

Maths

This week, we will be focussing on the following objectives:

- ☺ Identify, represent, and estimate numbers using different representations, including the number line.
- ☺ Compare and order numbers from 0 up to 100; use <, > and = signs.
- ☺ Use place value and number facts to solve problems.
- ☺ Count in steps of 10 from any number, forward and backward.



Learn It:

Encourage your child to explore the following calculation in lots of different ways [e.g. inverse, fact family, speed recall].

$$4 + 6 = 10$$

$$4 + 8 = 12$$
