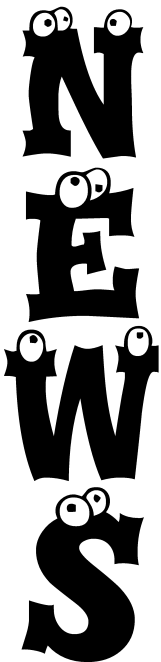
Please note that there has been a menu change for Thurs 4th October. If you have already ordered a meal for this day it will have been cancelled by the system. Please go an and re-book for this date.
