

Ferryhill Station Primary School – Uniform Policy

At Ferryhill Station Primary School, we believe that ‘smart’ means many things: skilled, hardworking and well-presented. In this instance, we have some clear expectations for the children’s appearance and the equipment they require.

Where uniform is not worn correctly, pupils will be reminded about the school uniform. Thereafter, a copy of the Uniform Policy will be sent home to individual parents. Please note that the law allows for Head Teachers to discipline a child for not wearing school uniform as defined by school governors.

Where a pupil is not wearing uniform because the parent cannot afford it, the Head Teacher must be informed; in certain circumstances, it is sometimes possible to access emergency financial support.

At Ferryhill Station Primary School, uniform is worn with pride and shows that the children all belong to the same school community; this should be celebrated. We wholeheartedly support the idea that high standards promote the best behaviour, support the most effective teaching and learning, and contribute to the ethos of the school.

School Dress Code

LOGO - Please note that the school sells uniform with the logo on. However, uniform without the school logo is generally available more cheaply in supermarkets.

PENCIL CASES - Pupils do not require a pencil case and stationery but they are welcome to bring their own into school at their own risk. Pupils who get their pen licence must use the pens provided by the school. Teachers may also ask for school stationery to be used exclusively in some lessons.

School Appearance Code

No earrings (pupils will be asked to remove these)

Ear studs are permitted (only if tape is provided by the parent to cover the stud for PE)

No tattoos (even temporary transfers)

No nail varnish (except medicated)

Smart haircuts only –

No haircuts that draw unnecessary attention

No hair dye

No shaved patterns
