Daily After School Club Potential Costs:

This proposed provision will need to be self-sustaining if we are to ensure the on-going provision of high quality, accessible, affordable and sustainable services. Therefore the cost of these services will be set at the level required to cover the cost of providing them. This is currently being calculated and the results of this questionnaire will help us to predict our needs. However, we have undertaken research and taken advice and indications are that costs are likely to be in the region of:

£15.00 for 3.15 – 6.00pm including main, hot meal.

£10.00 for 3.15-5.00pm snacks only.

£12.50 for 3.15 – 6.00pm including light meal and snacks.

Please note: Parents working for 16 hours or more may be eligible for Working Tax Credit (childcare element) which in many cases will cover a significant proportion of these fees.

Children may want to attend their existing school-based activities (football, Spanish, etc.) and then go into the after-school club. Please be aware that the after-school childcare club may still need to charge you the full cost of the session when this happens, because the necessary staffing levels must be maintained at all times.
